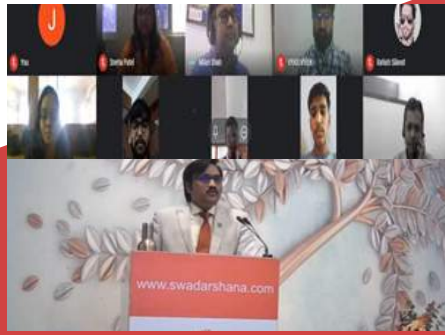
CAMPUS ACTIVITIES

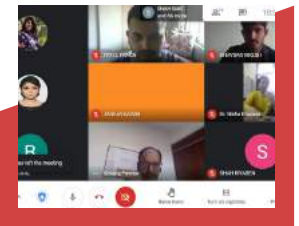


WOMEN'S DAY
