Report of Resource Centre – GIT (2010-2011)

Introduction

Any college's intellectual development purely depends on its library resources. Fully airconditioned Resource Centre (RC) of the Institute has a variety of resources including text books, reference books, journals Print & Electronics, CDs, magazines, news papers, etc. The RC, with state of the art facilities, also contains books on general soft skills, personality development, social development, managerial skills and others. Hence the RC provides all the resources required for all-round development of students which is the mission of the Institute. The major objective of the RC is to provide services like reference and consultation, membership and circulation, document delivery, resource sharing, information alert service, book bank for needy students, extra books facility for meritorious students, user awareness programs, and ICT-enabled web-based services.

Collection Development and Management

RC collection comprising of books, journals, reports and other reading material in Science, Engineering, Technology, Humanities, Social sciences and Management. During current academic year more than Rs 3 lacs have been spent for maintaining and updating the collection with new knowledge resources. The total collection of RC as on 31st March 2011 stands as follows:

Monthly alert is being sent to all the faculty members about new arrivals. An email alert is also sent to the faculty member(s) about the arrival of publications requested by them. Special care is being taken to neatly maintain the Resource Centre stacks to facilitate users to locate the desired resource quickly, and worn out labels were immediately replaced.

Automation

RC is fully automated. Every function of the RC has been operated by the software "SOUL 2.0". The OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) is one of the most heavily used functions of the software and is accessible during RC hours through PCs. Besides listing all the documents available in the RC, it allows reservation, circulation, fine collection, and indicates status of a particular book. OPAC is searchable by author, title, accession number, subject and several other fields.



Resource Centre Homepage

RC Homepage, which is under construction, will provide a single window to all the resources and services of RC. It will allow to:

- · Search/Browse the material in RC (Search OPAC)
- · Check the materials borrowed by a user and their due date
- · Access E-Resources (books, journals, theses, databases and multimedia products)
- · Download library membership form, Book suggestion form, RC guide
- · Locate RC material
- · Ask the librarian, to know more like Suggestions, Complaints & Queries.

Resource Centre Services

The RC aims to provide wide and efficient access to the needed information in a service-rich environment to all its users. It offers a package of high quality, user focused services to support the research, teaching and learning endeavors of faculty, students and staff.

- (1) Reference, Consultation & Circulation: Reference service helps users to make full use of resources and services. It provides necessary assistance to users in locating information or document of their choice. There are more than 100 reference documents which includes Dictionary, Encyclopedias, yearbooks etc. Approximately 150 documents are circulated daily which includes books, Magazines, Journals, CDs and DVDs. It is open from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm on all working days.
- (2) **Book Bank:** The Book Bank facility helps the socially and economically weaker students. The collection consists of the prescribed text books for undergraduate courses which are loaned to these students for complete semester. During the year 12 students availed this facility and borrowed approximately 72 books from this collection.
- (3) **Information Alert Services:** Alerts for new arrivals, arrival of requested resources, details of forthcoming national and international events are regularly sent to the staff members of the institute.
- (4) **Library Orientation:** Users education is an important regular activity of the RC to inform, alert, educate and train users about various resources and services of the RC. An orientation program was organized for newly admitted students
- (5) Inter Library Loan: Inter Library Loan facility plays very important role in research as well as paper presentation for the students and staff. Under this service the document which is not available in RC is made available for the consultation by borrowing the same from other organization or Institution.
- (6) Reprography: Photocopying service is one of important services offered by RC.
- (7) **E-resources**: Electronic journals have been subscribed which contains around 5700 bibliographic journals, 1500 full text journals and few open source electronic journals.

During the last academic year, 63 books are donated by Prof. V. L. Patel, Ex-Professor, Nirma University and 17 books are gifted by Dr N M Bhatt, Director of the institute and one book is gifted by Mr. Ruchir Parikh, Lecturer of the Institute.



Graphics Processing Unit

A graphics processing unit or GPU (also occasionally called visual processing unit or VPU) is a dedicated graphics rendering device for a personal computer, workstation, or game console. Modern GPUs are very efficient at manipulating and displaying computer graphics, and their highly parallel structure makes them more effective than general-purpose CPUs for a range of complex algorithms. A GPU can sit on top of a video card, or it can be integrated directly into the motherboard.

The technical definition:- "A single chip processor with integrated transform, lighting, triangle setup/clipping, and rendering engines that is capable of processing a minimum of 10 million polygons per second". A GPU implements a number of graphics primitive operations in a way that makes running them much faster than drawing directly to the screen with the host CPU. The most common operations for early 2D computer graphics include the BitBLT operation (combines several bitmap patterns using a RasterOp), usually in special hardware called a "blitter", and operations for drawing rectangles, triangles circles, and arcs. Modern GPUs also have support for 3D computer graphics, and typically include digital video-related functions.

GPU can be viewed as stream processor. A GPU can sit on top of a video card, or it can be integrated directly into the motherboard through AGP or PCI slot.

In 1980, The Commodore Amiga was the first mass-market computer to include a blitter in its video hardware, and IBM's 8514 graphics system was one of the first PC video cards to implement 2D primitives in hardware. By the early 1990s, the rise of Microsoft Windows sparked a surge of interest in high-speed, high-resolution 2D bitmapped graphics (which had previously

been the domain of Unix workstations and the Apple Macintosh). For the PC market, the dominance of Windows meant PC graphics vendors could now focus development effort on a single programming interface, Graphics Device Interface (GDI).

Direct3D 5.0 was the first version of the burgeoning API to really dominate the gaming market and stomp out many of the hardware-specific interfaces. With the advent of the OpenGL API and similar functionality in DirectX, GPUs added programmable shading to their capabilities. Each pixel could now be processed by a short program that could include additional image textures as inputs, and each geometric vertex could likewise be processed by a short program before it was projected onto the screen. NVIDIA was first to produce a chip capable of programmable shading, the *GeForce 3* (core named NV20).

Today, parallel GPUs have begun making computational inroads against the CPU, and a subfield of research, dubbed GPGPU for *General Purpose Computing on GPU*, has found its way into fields as diverse as oil exploration, scientific image processing, and even stock options pricing determination. There is increased pressure on GPU manufacturers from "GPGPU users" to improve hardware design, usually focusing on adding more flexibility to the programming model. The current dominators of the market are **AMD** (manufacturers of the ATI Radeon graphics chip line) and **NVIDIA** (manufacturers of the NVIDIA Geforce and NVIDIA Quadro graphics chip line.)




Fig2. Architecture of GeForce 7800 Core clock - Up to 550 Mhz Memory clock- Up to 1700 Mhz Memory bandwidth:- 54.4 GB/s Pixel/s, Up to 8800 Million **Key features of GeForce 9600 GT**
