A Report on

“Republic Day Celebration-2022”

(26th January 2022, Wednesday)

Introduction:

Gandhinagar Institute of Technology celebrated 73rd Republic Day on 26th January 2022, Wednesday. Owing to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, with certain precautionary measures, this occasion was celebrated in the presence of Director Dr. H N Shah, Shri. Haresh Rohera (Trustee, GIT) & Mrs. Vinita Rohera, faculties, Staff members & students. The event was organized by cultural committee of GIT under the guidance of Dr. H. N. Shah. With certain precautions taken, there were performances with the students followed by March past, Singing, & Dancing in order to show patriotism. To celebrate Republic Day, we have organized four Online events on 24th January 2022, which were Patriotic Poetry Craft - Poetry Competition, Creative Colors - Painting Competition, Quizalize - Online Quiz Competition & Extempore - Creative Idea Presentation.

Event Overview:

Description of Online Events held on 24/01/2022

Creative Colors - Painting Competition

Total 15 participants have registered for this painting competition. Painting competition was Theme-based in which we provided them three patriotic themes i.e. Freedom Fighters, Freedom and Social Change & Patriotism. Participants had to choose and draw one painting from the given Themes. Participants had to draw their painting in an online session on Google meet under the monitoring of faculty event coordinator and then after completion of competition participants had to send the picture of their painting immediately to faculty event coordinator within specified time limit. Armed with brushes and bright ideas our student participants participated enthusiastically. The entire event was coordinated by Prof. Pooja Patanwal, Asst. Prof, Civil Department. As per format of event Winner & Runner up were selected.

Extempore - Creative Idea Presentation

Total 17 participants have registered for this event. This event was based on patriotic theme & some of the major contemporary issues like Ayushman Bharat Yojana: A New Initiative, Green Energy in India, Cyber Crime- A technological nightmare etc. There was total two rounds of the event & entire event was judged by Prof. Hardik Bhatt sir, HOD of EC & EE departments. The entire event was coordinated by Dr. Nehal Shah, Asst. Prof, MBA department. The event was anchored by MBA semester 3 student- Miss. Drashti Patel. As per format of event Winner & Runner up were selected.

Quizalize - Online Quiz Competition

Total 84 participants have registered for this event. This quiz event was on the virtual Platform Google Meet via Kahoot App. It was a competition where participants showcased their brainstorming talent by attending different questionnaires based on the patriotic

theme. We used “Kahoot Platform” for the multiple-choice quizzes that was played/accessed via a web browser or the Kahoot app. The entire event was coordinated by Prof. Shreya Patel, Asst. Prof, Computer department. As per format of event Winner & Runner up were selected.

Patriotic Poetry Craft - Poetry Competition

Total 6 participants have registered for this event. This event was based on patriotic poetry recitation on given themes like Struggle for India Independence, Warriors’ contribution for Indian independence, Indian Constitution and Democracy, Real meaning for the celebration of Republic Day & Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav. All participants were given 5 minutes for the patriotic poetry in the first round. Selected 4 were given randomly any patriotic theme in the final round. The entire event was coordinated by Prof. Chintan Barelwala, Asst. Prof, Mechanical department. As per format of event Winner & Runner up were selected.

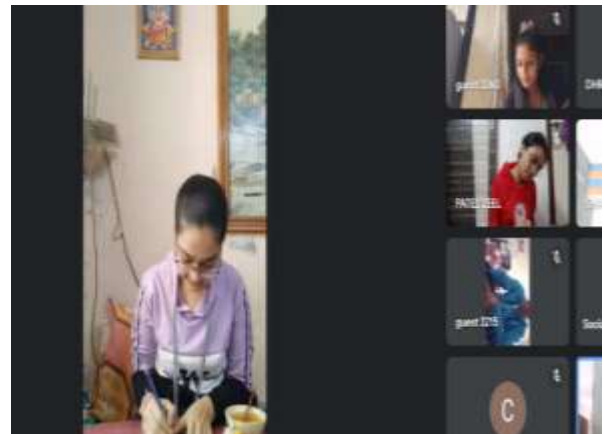
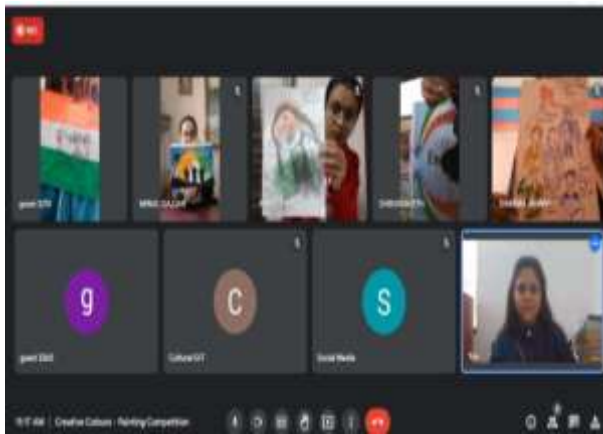
Details of Republic Day Celebration

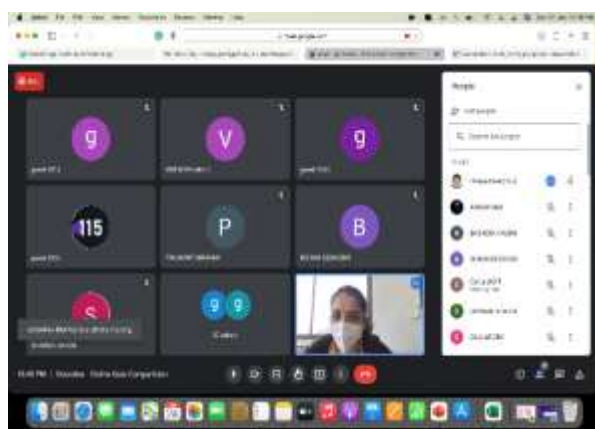
