He was mentioned achievements of SSIP 1.0 and He gave the information about SSIP 2.0 that Overall Financial Support in 5 Years is 500 cr, Budget allocation by Government for 5 years is 300 cr, Outreach to 1.5 million students from higher and Technical Education, 3.5 million students from School, Stakeholders of the policy are State, University/Institute, Schools, Beneficiary (extension to school students and even drop outs), Scope of inclusivity is Extending support to all streams within the education paradigm, 10,000 PoCs / Prototypes to be supported, 5000 Ips to be supported in filing, 500 Grantees Educational Institutions (Grantees) to be supported, 1500 Start-ups to be supported, INR 2.5 Lakh Allocation per PoC / Prototype at idea level, 10,000 Faculty Members to be supported Faculty Development Program.

Prof Mrugesh Khatri mentioned about Eligibility to receive SSIP 2.0 Grant(For Individual Beneficiaries) Any person up to the age of 35 years, who school student of

Foundational/Preparatory/Middle/Secondary level (Up to Class 12)A Diploma/Vocational/Undergraduate/Postgraduate/Doctoral student or an alumna/alumnus, Any dropout from School/Institute/University. The innovation of the beneficiary should contribute towards either development or improvement of any product or process or service in existing or new fields; or should be a scalable business model with a potential to generate employment or wealth creation.

The event was a grand success under the enlightenment of Dr H N Shah, Director of the institute and the participants.










