- Around 35 participants attended the alumni talk including students, faculties and alumni and learned about the precast construction technology in CL domain.

Objective of the event:

The objective of the Alumni Talk Series - ‘Abhivyakti’ is to organize interactions on a digital platform among current students and alumni on career opportunities and emerging trends of industry in different domains. The experiences and knowledge of alumni who have excelled in performance in their respective fields can motivate and guide the current students of GIT.

Brief Profile of the speaker:

Mr. Ravi Nishant has pursued his Bachelor’s degree in Civil Engineering from GIT in 2014. He has worked as Product management intern at Emproto Technologies. Now he is going to join Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages, the Indian arm of Coca-Cola. He is pursuing his master degree in management from National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE), Mumbai which is known as “Mecca of Supply chain”.

Activities during the event:

Under the banner of Gandhinagar Institute of Technology Alumni Association (GITAA), GIT invited his Alumnus Mr. Ravi Nishant of batch 2014-2018 from Civil Engineering department for an expert session on “Management as Career Option”. He is pursuing his master degree in management from National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE), Mumbai which is known as “Mecca of Supply chain”.

The expert session was held on 18-07-2020 during 11:00 to 12:15 pm on Google Meet platform. Prof Jignesh Vaniya gave an introductory speech about the speaker of the session Mr. Ravi Nishant. Around 35 students, alumni and faculties participated in this expert talk on Management as career option as in general as well as in engineering branch specific. Alumni Ravi Nishant inspired the students with the story of his journey in Civil Engineering field, how he motivated himself from college activity and how he prepared himself for CAT exam in 2019. He explained about the opportunities for an CL engineer in the fields of Management either it is operational management or product manufacturing management, He gave the total insight of

MBA, how to prepare for it, who can apply for it. Every detail was discussed thoroughly to make career in MBA. He also talked about job opportunities after completion of MBA.

He guided the students about the necessary skill sets to be developed for becoming good managerial person after completion of MBA who is ready to work like in various situations, production, construction, HR and other areas. He gave information about types of colleges based on tiers like cloud 1, cloud 2 and cloud 3, which represents the college for MBA in terms of college fees, entrance exams to apply for, result criteria and importance of their in placement criteria. He gave example of a college which is taking so many entrance exams so students can easily join or apply for admission. He gave example of current issue Covid19 due to which many issues are arising in human resource management and how to manage workers and their respective work. He solved many queries of the students regarding career choices and job opportunities in CL and other branch specific domains. He also encourages students to follow their conventional methods to be prepared for CAT and other entrance exams for MBA in top colleges of India rather following blindly others by joining various institutes for coaching. He also talked about how to mentally prepare and study the different materials. He also gave few advices regarding students who are having different background than MBA. The session was concluded with vote of thanks given by faculties of the CL department.

Outcomes of the event:

The Alumni Talk has facilitated interactions of students with alumni for career development & skills needed for grasping better job opportunities. The students were very enthusiastic to learn about present industry scenario in Civil Engineering field.


