Ms Ishita Ambani has pursued and completed his Bachelor’s degree in Electronics & Communication Engineering from GIT in 2017. She is working as a Business Associate in NITOR Infotech, a tech company based out in Pune and her role is to get the business for the company using sales tactics and strategies.

## **Activities during the event:**

Under the banner of Gandhinagar Institute of Technology Alumni Association (GITAA), GIT invited her Alumna Ms Ishita Ambani of batch 2013-2017 from Electronics & Communication Engineering department for an expert session on “Your Network is the Network”.

The expert session was held on 25-07-2020 during 11:00 to 12:30 pm on Google Meet platform. Prof Mitul Maniar gave an introductory speech about the speaker of the session Ms Ishita Ambani. Around 31 students, alumni and faculties participated in this expert talk on “Your Network is the Network”. Alumni Ms. Ishita Ambani inspired the audience with her story of her journey from GIT to being an Industry Professional, dealing with people from a wide range of domains. Ishita started with an introduction to what kind of person she was during her college days and her experiences during college fests, which made her realize that networking is an unspoken but important trait to be developed. She slowly cultivated the habit of keeping in touch with all people that she met during her college days. Eventually when she left GIT and landed into a job at Pune, the drive and urge to connect to people and to give back to the society kicked

in again and she found herself working on the weekends with an NGO, teaching students from slum or poor financial background and being a part of their life story. She shared many a touching experiences of her time with that NGO. The point of focus then was how to cultivate and maintain networks. Ishita emphasized on the importance of LinkedIn in corporate sector and how that helps people network with each other. She shared a few examples of making connections with strangers but like-minded people on account of using the said methods. Ishita concluded with the thought of everyone using the ideas and concepts of networking to the most benefit of their own selves and each other too.

The talk on Networking with Ishita Ambani was very insightful for people of all ages, be it college going students or working professionals. The session was excellent, and students got inspired by her life experiences, doing selfless work with children and educating them, good networking development through genuine efforts, living with gratitude etc.

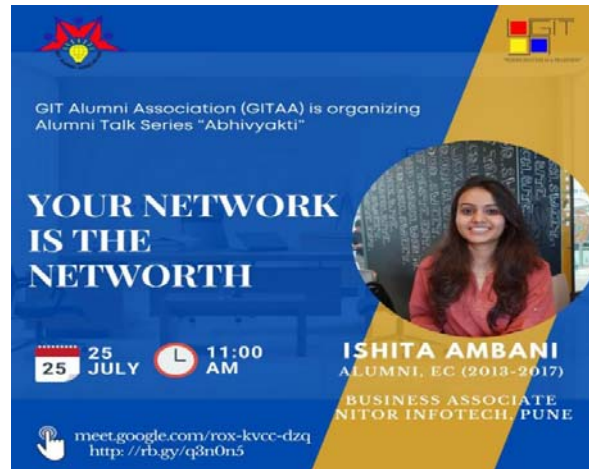

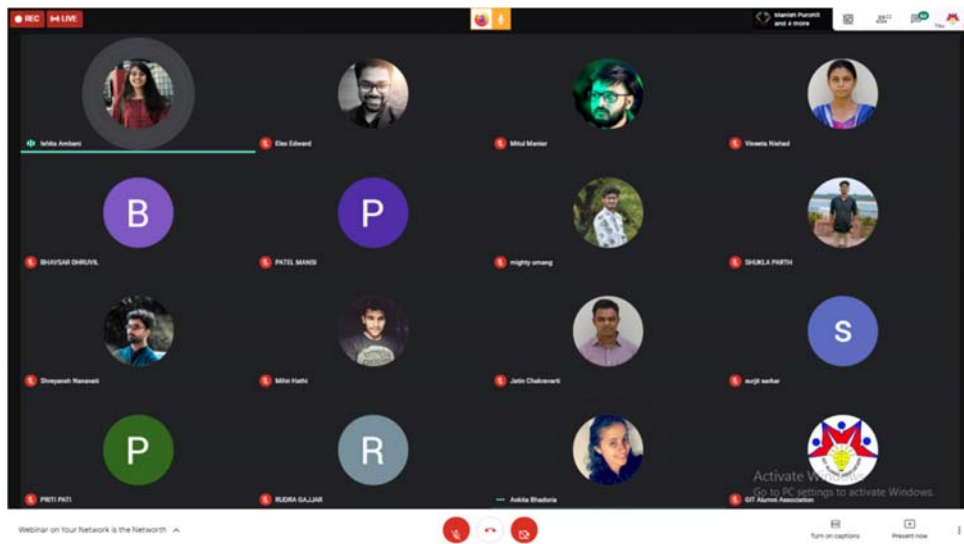

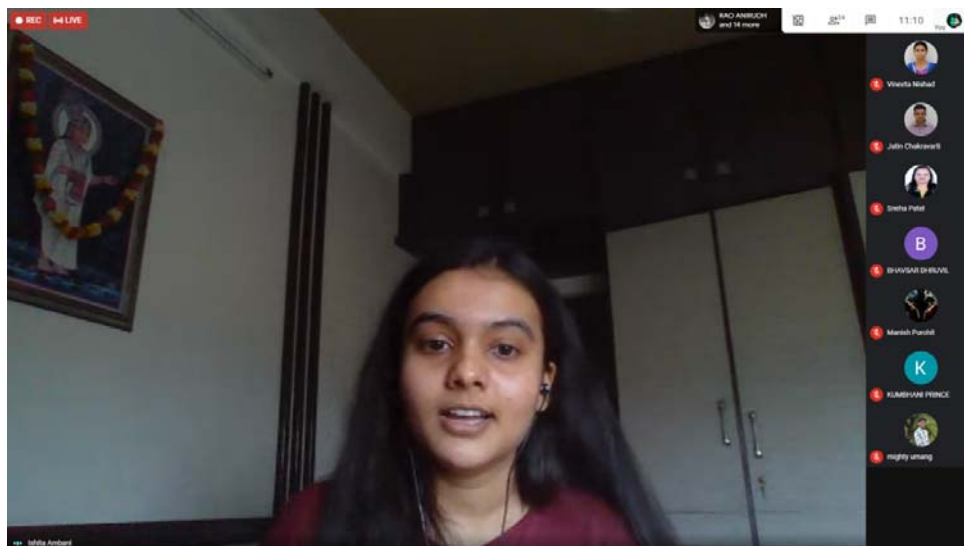

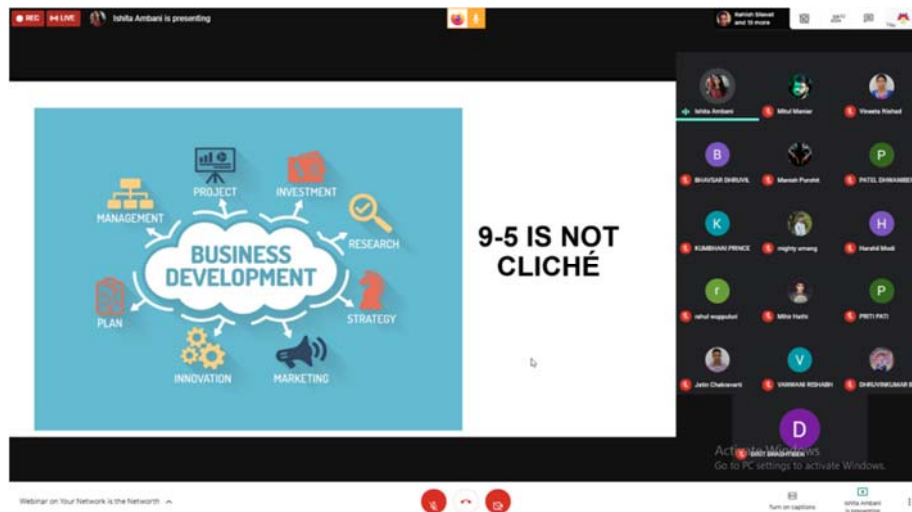

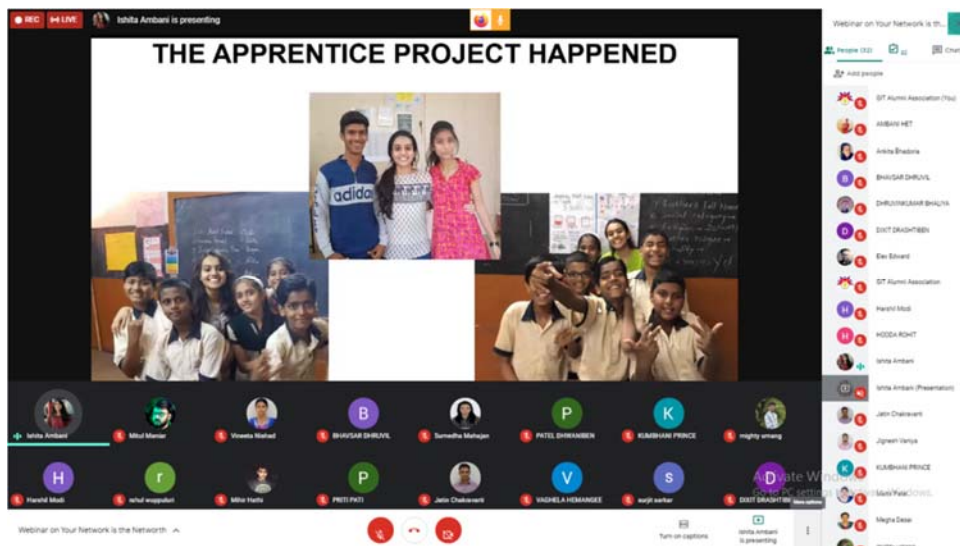

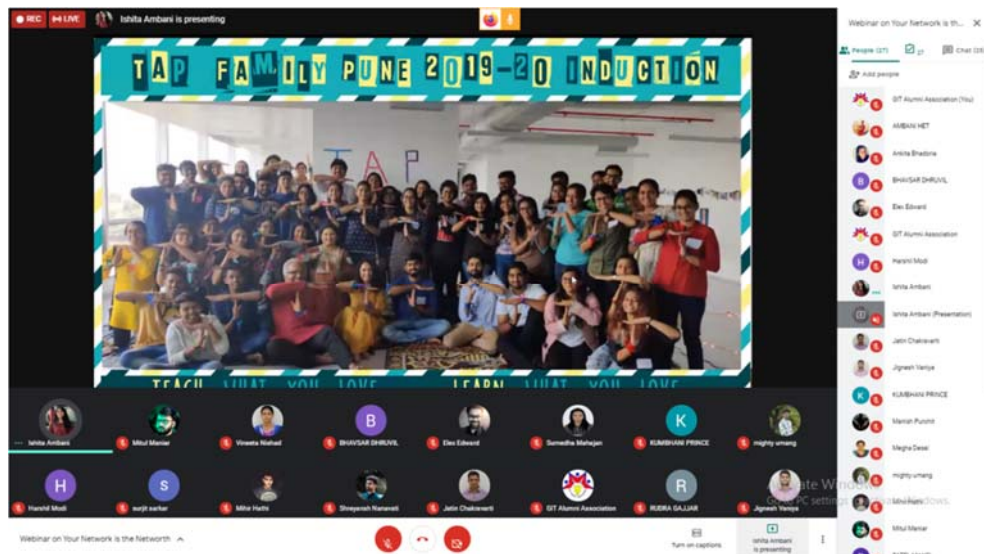

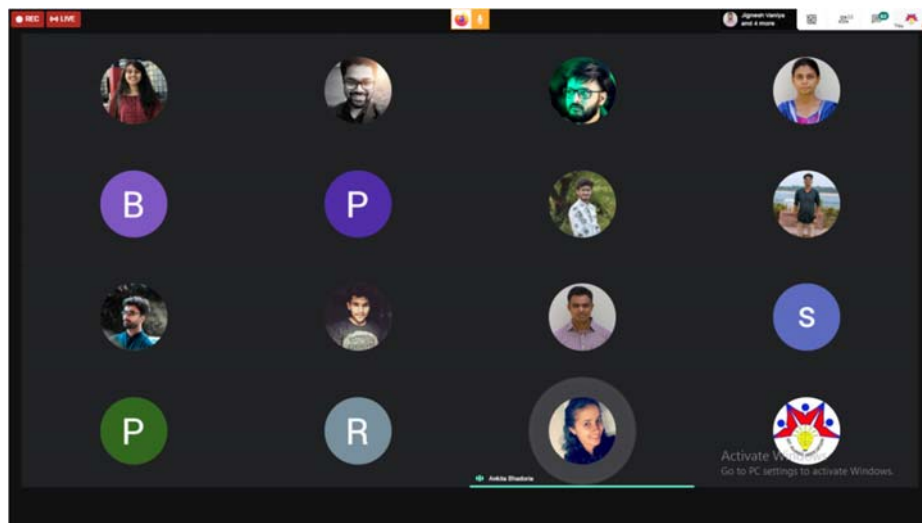

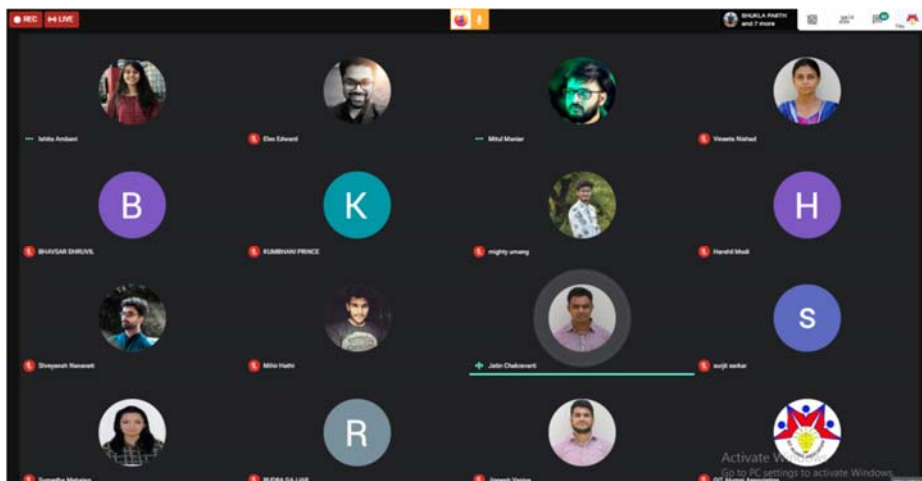
