Sub: Evaluation of M component

All the students of BE are hereby informed that, for the current semester (Odd 2017-18), Continuous Evaluation component ('M' component) of 30 marks for all subjects will be evaluated by conducting a class test of 20 marks and ALA of 10 marks. All the students will be allowed to appear in second class test of 20 marks which will be considered as remedial for those who secured less than passing marks after first class test and ALA. Best of the marks obtained from the two class test will be considered for those who will secure more than passing marks after first class test and ALA. Accordingly marks will be forwarded to the Gujarat Technological University.

There may be few subjects from old GTU syllabus which are offered to the students under equivalency during different semesters. Continuous Evaluation component ('M' component) of 30 marks for all such subjects will be evaluated by conducting a class test of 30 marks.

Remedial examination of 'M' component will be conducted by taking one class test of 20 marks and ALA of 10 marks (new syllabus) and one class test of 30 marks (old syllabus) for all the students who have failed in 'M' component till last semester. The syllabus will be the same as that of GTU. Detail time table of the examination has been displayed on institute website.

It has been observed that many students who have backlog in 'M' and/or 'V' component appear for respective examination however they do not fill the GTU exam form for the same. Under this circumstances enrollment number of the students will not be available on GTU portal and their backlog will not be cleared even though the students have passed the respective examination. So all the students having backlog in 'M' and/or 'V' component only are advised to fill the GTU exam form as per scheduled declared by GTU.
