Schedule of the Event:

The program was divided into day events and night events.

Brief summary of the day event is as follow

- **Spell-o-thon**

It was a competition in which participants were asked to spell a broad selection of words with varying difficulty.

No. of Group: 34

- **Sher-o-shyari**

It was an event of poem and shayari. Participants had be given two options either they make their own poem / shayari or they could bring another person's poem / shayari and present if he/she agrees.
