“Felicitation of GIT at Healthy Campus Event”

Introduction:

Gandhinagar Institute of Technology participated in the 'International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking' celebrations on 26th June 2019, at Chippa Community Centre, Astodia, Ahmedabad. The event was organized by 'High on Life' Foundation and 'IST' in association with Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB). The event was supported by 'Healthy Campus' and 'Srishti Bharat' foundation.

Objective:

'International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking' was organized to sensitize the students, parents and teachers about the harmful effects of narcotics. It is observed that college students are vulnerable to drug abuse. It is found that smoking and tobacco consumption is traditionally the first step towards drugs, as one addiction is not enough and the person yearns for more. Program Overview:
