About Webinar :

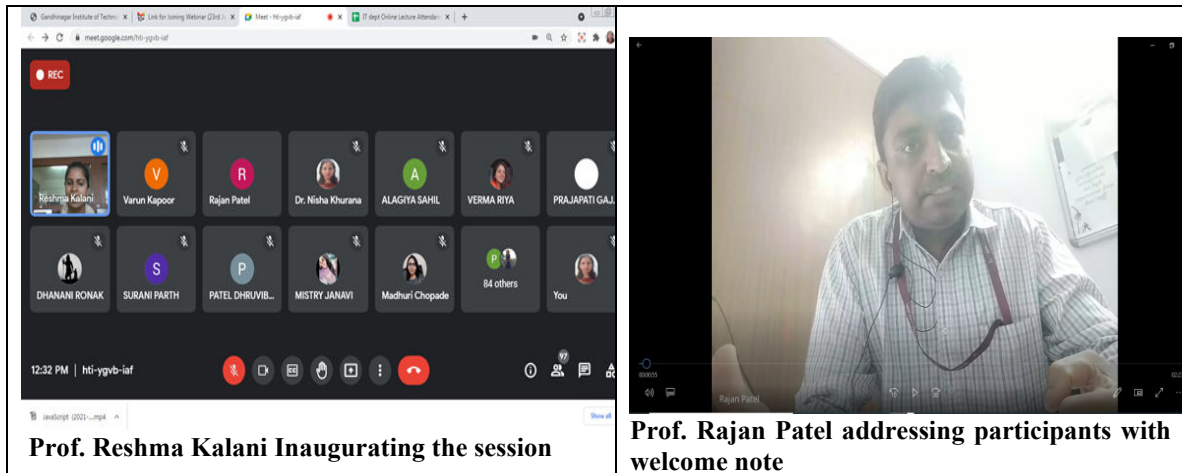

Content of speaker:

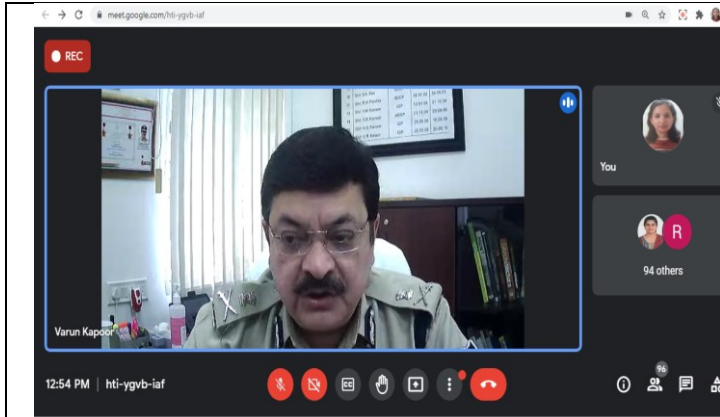
Shri Varun Kapoor discussed about various threats in current era and one of them which is prevailing is cyber threats and crime. He discussed why cyber threat is biggest threat to public security. Cyber threats are different and so more challenging. It does not require the entities to be present physically. It happens virtually and is stay at home crime. He discussed use of cyber space in terms of information, commerce, communication, social networking etc. He explained about transmission of data through social media should be done consciously and cautiously. He explained what are digital footprints and how with help of it, culprits are caught.

Awareness among youth and people is only and best weapon to mitigate the cyber threats. Along with awareness, monitoring is important. He discussed cyber-crime such as cyber bullying, cyber stalking, online gaming, pedophiles that are affecting youth and children and the ways to overcome and prevent oneself of being victim of it.

He discussed phishing attacks and cyber-world real case studies that were enriching and enlightening.



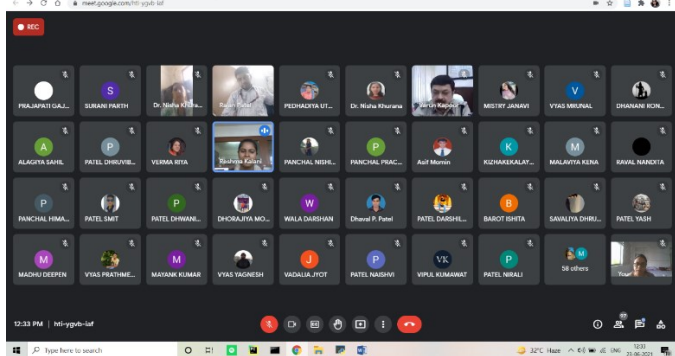
Glimpse of webinar on “Awareness-Main tool for Citizen Cyber Security”



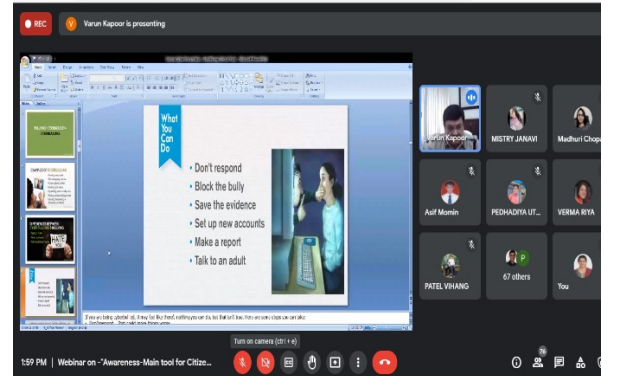
Dr. Varun Kapoor explaining Cyber Security Awareness

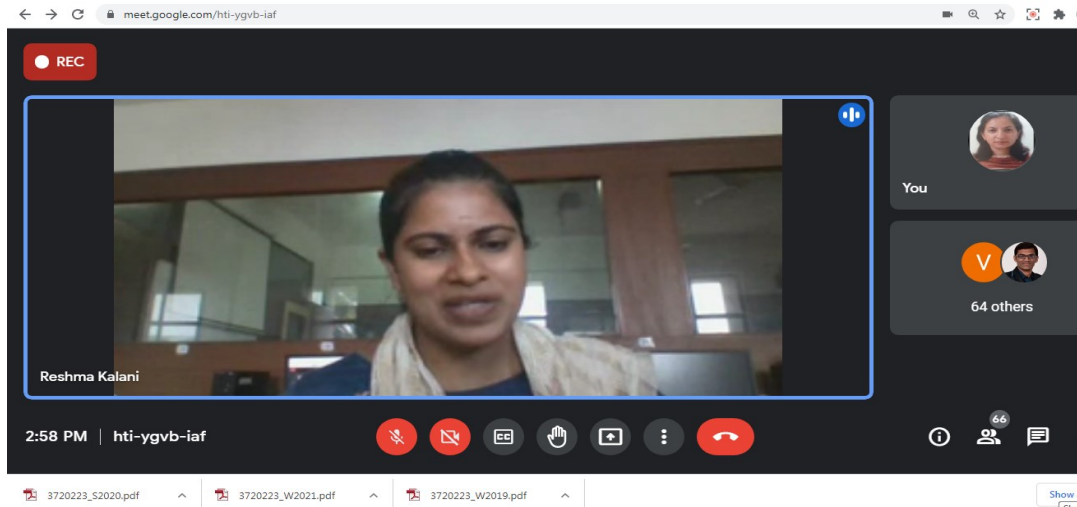


Explanation of Solutions in case of Cyber Bullying
