Introduction

As part of the Techxtreme Fest celebrations, Gandhinagar Institute of Law successfully conducted a Judgment Writing Competition titled “The Verdict”, which was specially curated to offer law students a platform to develop and exhibit their judicial reasoning, legal articulation, and writing skills. The competition witnessed active student involvement and intellectual engagement, thereby contributing to the academic and professional growth of the participants.

Detailed Report

The event drew 26 to 30 registrations from students enrolled across various law programs at Gandhinagar Institute of Law. Each participant was presented with hypothetical criminal and civil case scenarios, for which they had to draft comprehensive and legally sound judgments. This exercise encouraged them to apply legal reasoning, analyze facts, refer to relevant precedents, and articulate their decisions in a structured judicial format.

The core objective of this event was to enhance the analytical thinking, practical understanding, and judgment writing capabilities of budding legal professionals. The participants showcased a remarkable grasp over legal doctrines and courtroom logic, demonstrating their commitment to learning and growth in the legal domain.

After a thorough evaluation of the entries, the event concluded with the declaration of winners. Zalak Srivastav, a student of BA LLB Semester 2, was declared Runner-Up, and Naman Upadhyay from LLB Semester 2 secured the Winner’s position. Both winners were awarded cash prizes in recognition of their outstanding performance.
