## Event Overview:

The 5<sup>th</sup> National Pharmacovigilance week was celebrated on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2025 under the theme “Your Safety, Just a Click Away: Report to PvPI” at Gandhinagar Institute of Pharmacy, Gandhinagar University. The program was designed to raise awareness regarding the significance of pharmacovigilance, adverse drug reaction (ADR) monitoring, and patient safety among students and faculty members. The event successfully integrated academic learning with creative student participation, fostering a culture of safe and rational medicine use.

## Objective:

The primary objective of the program was to sensitize pharmacy students to the critical role of pharmacovigilance in ensuring public health and patient safety. The initiative aimed to educate participants on systematic ADR monitoring and reporting procedures while promoting active engagement with the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI).
